

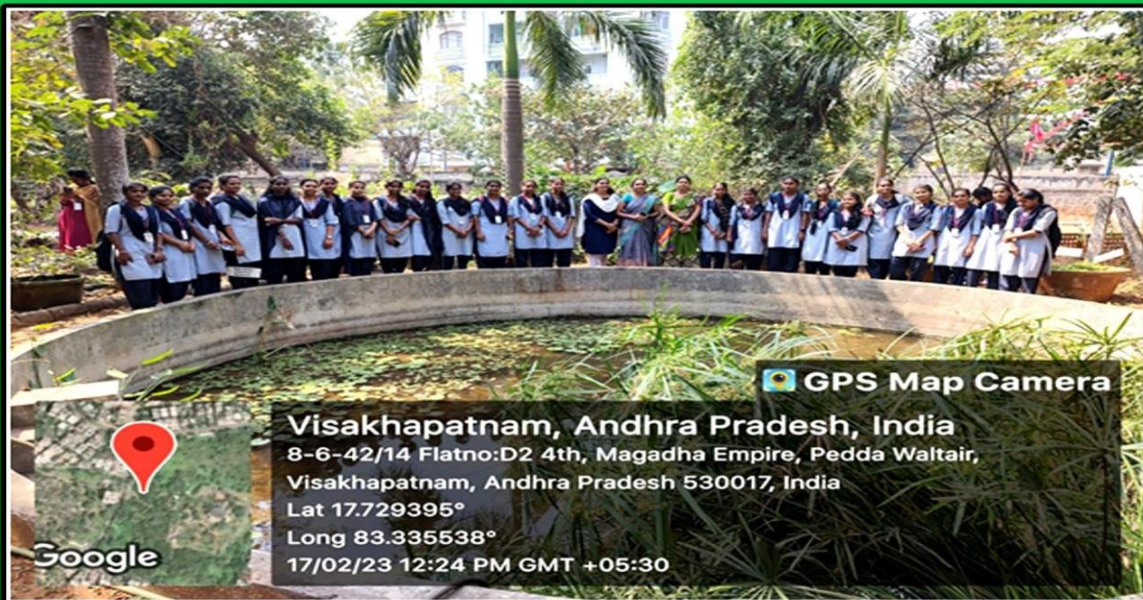
BIODIVERSITY PARK (DOLPHIN CONSERVATION SOCIETY)
