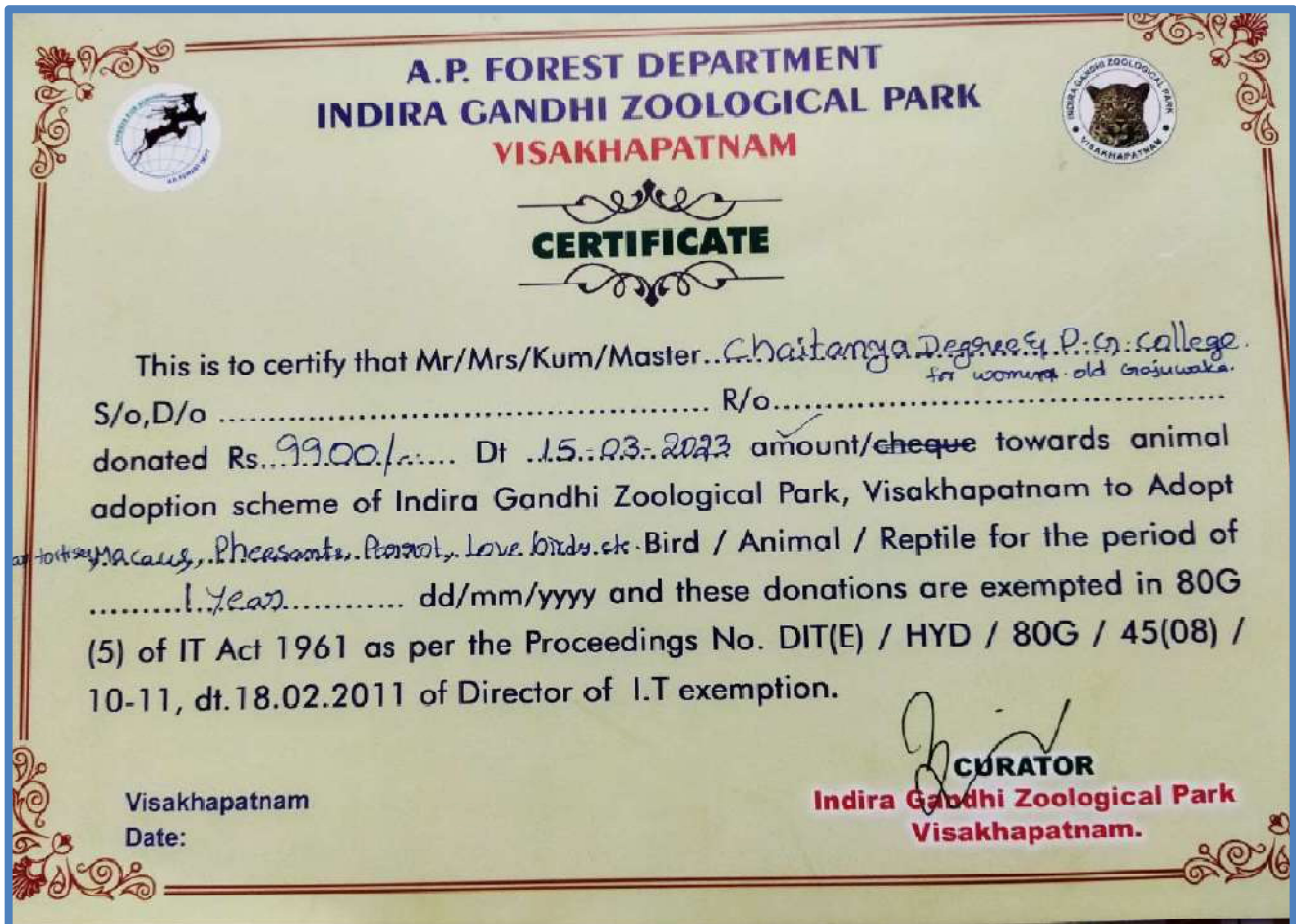




WORLD WILD LIFE DAY [MARCH- 3-2023]

HISTORY

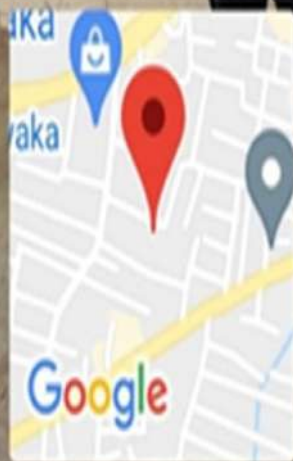

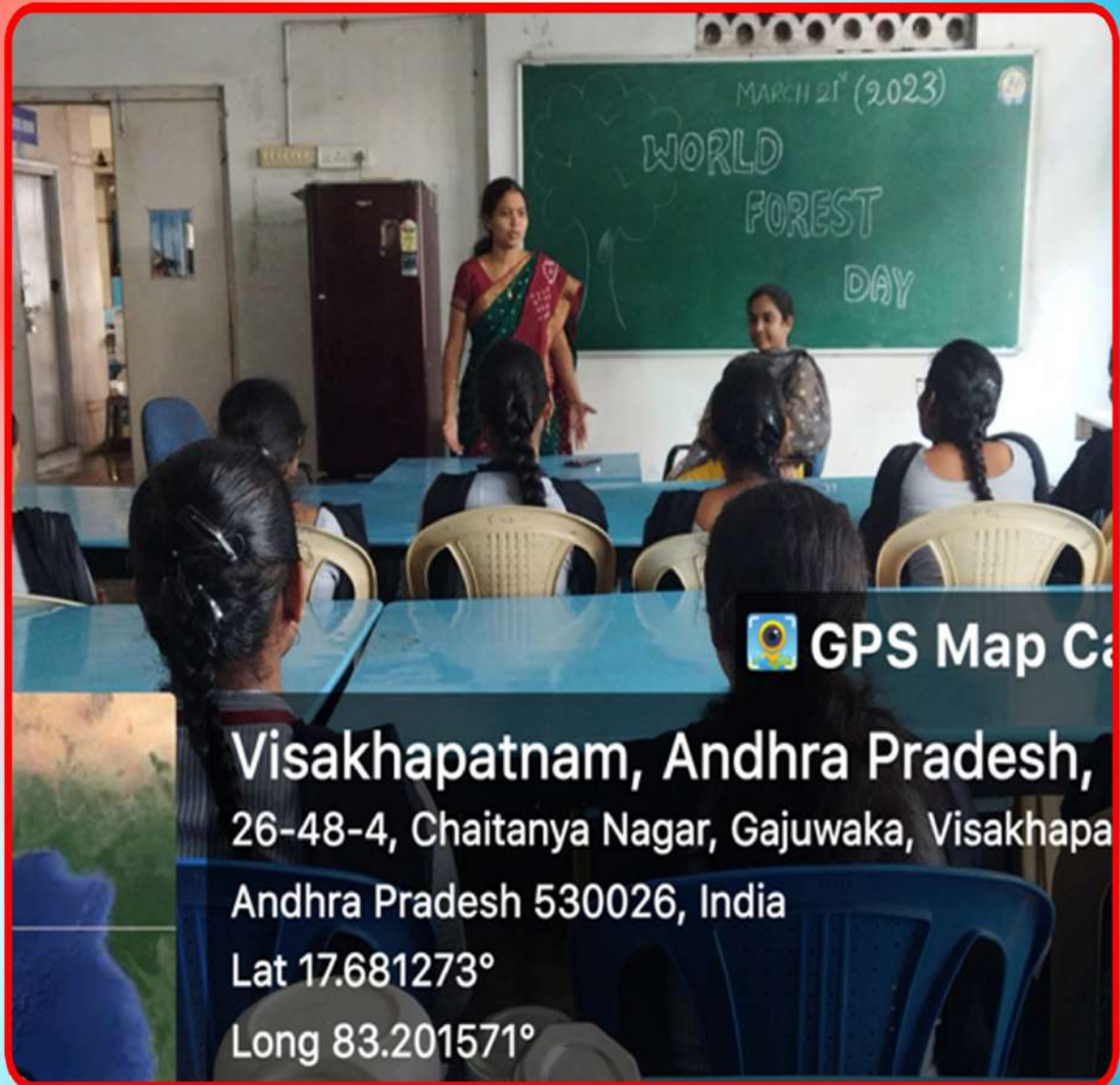


 GPS Map

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WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY [JUNE 5]

HISTORY

World Environment Day was established in 1972 by the United Nations at the Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment, that had resulted from discussions on the integration of human interactions and the environment. One year later, in 1973 the first WED was held with the theme "Only One Earth".

The World Environment Day 2022 is hosted by Sweden. "Only One Earth" is the campaign slogan, with the focus on "Living Sustainably in Harmony with Nature".
