### HISTORY

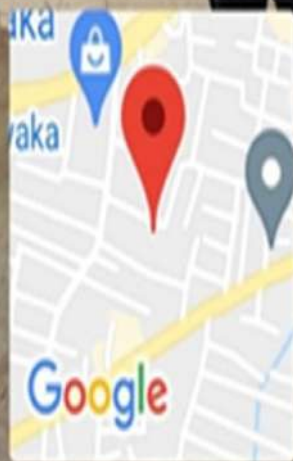
